WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

This juried exhibit is open to all **high school students** in the CSRA. Individual students or their teachers may submit two- or three-dimensional student work in any media for judging.

HOW CAN I SUBMIT MY ARTWORK FOR JUDGING?

Read the entry procedures, fill out the required form, and submit your work for judging. We will accept good-quality slides, photographs, digital images, or the actual artwork. **Labeled art accompanied by the appropriate paperwork** must be submitted to the Morris in person or by mail or email December 12, 2014.

WHY SHOULD I ENTER?

This is an exciting opportunity to exhibit your work at the Morris Museum of Art, the first museum dedicated to the art and artists of the South. Your participation will strengthen your resume, as universities and future employers look for applicants with outstanding accomplishments.

Entry Procedures:

- Individual Students or their teachers can submit **student** work.
- Two entries per student. Teachers can submit up to 10 student works, with no more than two works per student.
- Two-dimensional or three-dimensional works in any media will be accepted.
- We will accept good-quality slides, photographs, digital images, or the actual artworks for judging. **We prefer photos or digital images for judging.**
- **All submitted slides, photographs, digital images, and/or actual artwork must be labeled with the artist's name, phone number, e-mail address, school and teacher's name, title, media, and dimensions.**
- All two-dimensional works must be NEATLY matted, mounted, or framed (with wire).
- A completed and signed entry form (below) is required for each artist.
- **Entries can be mailed, emailed, or brought to the Morris Museum between 10:00–4:45 (noon–4:45 on Sunday).**

Important dates:

December 8–12: Entries may be submitted to the museum	January 5–9: Accepted entries must be brought to the museum
December 12: Deadline for email or mail entries	January 14: First day of exhibition
December 15: Notification of acceptance by <u>email</u>	February 1: Last day of exhibition
December 15–19: Work not selected must be picked up	February 2–6: Work must be picked up
